Pewinski moved, Huff supported, to adopt the Proposed 2021-22 General Fund Budget with starting balance on hand of \$ 575,307.46; expected Revenues of \$ 391,015.00 ; expected Expenditures of \$ 632,450.00 ; expected Contingency Fund of \$ 333,872.46.  
Ayes, all. Motion carried.

Pewinski moved, Samkowiak supported, to adopt the Proposed 2021-22 Fire/EMS Account Budget with a starting balance of \$ 359,442.45 ; expected Revenues of \$ 106,800.00 ; expected Expenditures of \$ 165,950.00 ; expected Contingency Fund of \$ 300,292.45.  
Ayes, all. Motion carried.

Samkowiak moved, McCarthy supported, to set 2021-22 salary for Supervisor at \$ 23,465.76  
Ayes, all. Motion carried.

Nowak moved, McCarthy supported, to set 2021-22 salary for Treasurer at \$ 33,460.56  
Ayes, all. Motion carried.

Samkowiak moved, Huff supported, to set Clerk salary for 2021-22 at \$ 24,246.84  
Ayes, all. Motion carried.

Pewinski moved, McCarthy supported, to set Trustee salary for 2021-22 at \$ 5,440.92 per trustee.  
Ayes, all. Motion carried.
